

## **REPORTING YOUR POSITION TO WINLINK??!!**

Why should you report your position on Winlink??

There are several very good reasons!!

You can receive information on:

- closeby telpacs and PMBOs
- closeby winlink stations

It also enables a central point, like an EOC, to plot all the Winlink activity on one map very easily!

You can do all these activities in Airmail or Paclink or even on the Winlink webmail!  
(But it is a whole lot easier in Airmail)

Try it! Very few people are using these features as present and it is really easy to use

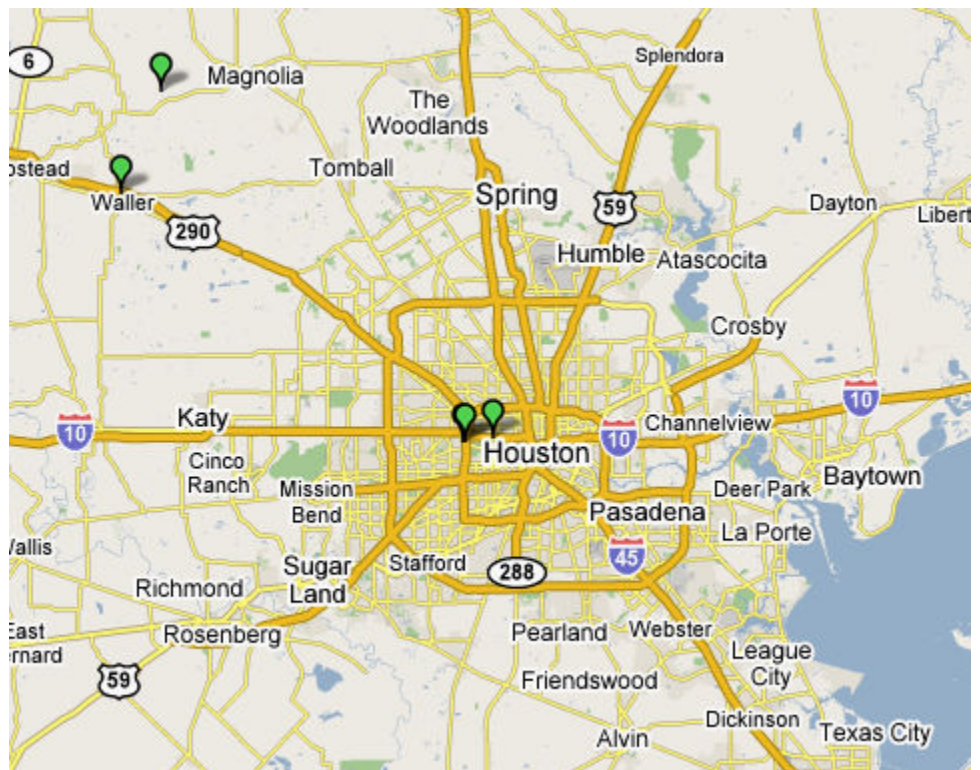
How to post your position in Airmail:

- go to Window/Position Reports
- enter Latitude in the form of 29°46.55'N
- enter Longitude in the form of 095°25.19'W  
(This can be obtained automatically if you connect a GPS)
- enter the Date/Time or click Now
- add Comments if you wish
- Click on Send Now
- Click on Close
- You will find a message posted in your Outbox
- Connect to a PMBO via HF, telnet or telpac to send it.

That's it!
